Allcyte is a seed-phase biotechnology startup located in Vienna, Austria. With our Pharmacoscopy[®] high content imaging platform we leverage state-of-the-art automated fluorescence microscopy and proprietary computational image analysis to profile anticancer drug activity in primary human tissues. We focus on generating unique mechanistic insights into drug action that overcome the limitations of working with mouse models or cell lines to support the efficient translation of drug candidates from bench to bedside and plan clinical trials with improved chances of success.

Work with Pharmacoscopy[®] uniquely enables us to investigate direct effects as well as immunomodulatory properties of drugs through the robust quantification of visible phenotypes in fresh primary patient samples, *ex vivo*, with single cell resolution. Properties, which we have successfully leveraged to offer our partners in the pharmaceutical industry a reliable tool to assess drug activity for pre-clinical and clinical development applications. Moreover, we integrate our existing datasets with genetics to discover new biomarkers predictive of drug action (see Schmidl & Vladimer *et al*, Nature Chemical Biology 2019). An earlier prototype of our diagnostics platform was tested in the course of the academic EXALT study run by CeMM, the Center for Molecular Medicine of the Austrian Academy of Sciences, and the Medical University of Vienna and has been able to help physicians identify highly effective personalized salvage therapies that significantly increase the response rate of late stage hematological cancer patients and prolong their progression free survival (Snijder & Vladimer *et al*, Lancet Haematology 2017).
